DROUGHT COMMUNITIES PROGRAM FUNDING – EMPLOYMENT OPPORTUNITIES

On Friday, 26 October 2018, the Federal Government announced the extension of the Drought Communities Program (DCP) under which eligible council's in drought affected areas can apply for up to \$1 million to spend on locally identified projects aimed at *stimulating the local economy and maintaining jobs*, the District Council of Streaky Bay was fortunate in being included in the latest round of declarations.

Council is inviting applications for a casual labour and project management position(s) for persons to assist with and implement the projects that include;

- Water Storage and Pipe Laying
- Trenching and Excavation
- Building Works
- Paving
- General Civil Construction
- Shared Use Trail Construction (including Trail Building Training)

Projects are required to be completed by June 30, 2019, therefore applicants will need to be available during this time to ensure project and funding deadlines are met.

Priority will be given to farmers or agricultural workers where applicable, however there may be alternative casual work available and therefore any person(s) seeking casual labour may apply.
